Swing N' Steam at Downpatrick Railway Museum

This weekend (14th & 15th August) sees the 60th Anniversary of Glenn Miller's visit to Northern Ireland, and so the steam train at Downpatrick Railway Museum is the perfect way to recapture the memories of a rural 1940s passenger train.

To mark this special occasion, there'll be 1940s sounds on the platform to get everyone, from railway buffs to children and families, "*In the Mood.*"

After the trip, passenger will have the chance to go on a guided tour of the workshops and the behind-the-scenes work of the project, and the "Thomas the Tank Engine" model railway will be running in the Exhibition Room to keep the children amused.

Trains run 2pm till 5pm and tickets cost £4.50 adults, £3.50 children or senior citizens, and children aged three years old or below go free. There's no need to book and a ticket lasts all day.
